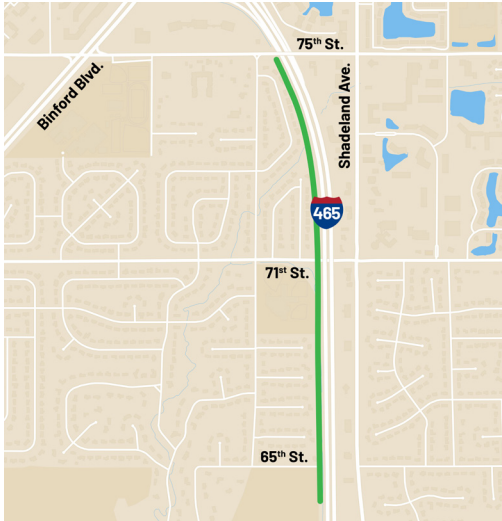


**ATTENTION: Noise barrier relocation will begin soon in your area.**



- ▶ **Who:** The Clear Path 465 project
- ▶ **What:** Removing noise barriers and state highway fence
- ▶ **Where:** Along the west side of I-465 southbound from 75th Street to Skiles Test Nature Park
- ▶ **When:** Starting on or after Monday, May 23
- ▶ **Why:** To rebuild and add lanes to I-465, including regrading side slopes and ditches

**Noise barriers are being removed to accommodate construction. They're expected to be replaced in about a year.**

**Residents using state highway fence or noise barriers as a pet or other enclosure should plan for their temporary removal.**

## What is Clear Path 465?

Clear Path 465 includes added travel lanes, new and rehabilitated bridges and interchange modifications to improve safety and traffic flow on I-465 and I-69 where they connect on the northeast side of Indianapolis.



## Will noise levels change?




Residents should expect a temporary increase in noise when barriers are removed. Replacement barriers are designed to address noise levels predicted for future traffic.

## How will the new noise barriers look?

Both the highway and residential sides of the noise barrier are expected to closely match the light gray ashlar stone texture of existing panels on the north and east sides of Indianapolis.
